

Quick Guide: **FACTOR 2026** Grants for renewable energy in the Balearic Islands

The FACTOR 2026 programme (Insularity Factor) offers non-repayable grants for aerothermal heat pumps, battery storage and electric-vehicle charging infrastructure in the Balearic Islands. Grants are awarded on a strict first-come, first-served basis until the budget runs out.

What, who and when?



What is subsidised?

Aerothermal heat pumps, batteries (up to 100 kWh eligible) and private EV charging points.



Who can apply?

Individuals resident in the Balearic Islands · private households and the self-employed.



When to apply?

From 9 July 2026 to 28 February 2027, or until funds run out. Strict order of arrival: speed is key!

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*Percentages apply to the eligible cost set by the call, which may be lower than the actual budget. Figures per the 2026-2027 call; check amounts, deadlines and requirements in the BOIB. Batteries from 100 to 200 kWh (455 €/kWh): ask us.

Key figures and requirements



ITEM	GRANT	MAX. ELIGIBLE COST
 Aerothermal heat pump	70 %	€1,000/kWt · grant cap €25,000
 Batteries up to 10 kWh	45 %	€910/kWh
 Batteries from 10 to 100 kWh	45 %	€650/kWh
 EV charging point	70 %	Grant cap €2,500 per installation



Important: solar photovoltaic installations that include a battery can also access FACTOR 2026 for the battery portion.



Indicative examples

- Aerothermal: €10,000 project (€1,000/kWt) → approx. grant of **€7,000** (70%)
- 10 kWh battery: €6,000 project (€600/kWh) → approx. grant of **€2,700** (45%)
- Charging point: €6,000 project → 70% capped at **€2,500**

Combine with income tax relief · Recover up to 75%
