

Quick Guide: FOTOPAR 2026 subsidies for renewable energy in the Balearic Islands



The FOTOPAR 2026 program offers non-refundable grants to promote new photovoltaic solar energy installations and storage systems (batteries) in the Balearic Islands. Grants are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until the €2,000,000 budget is exhausted.

What, Who, and When?



Who can apply for it?

Individuals residing in the Balearic Islands, both private individuals and self-employed.



What is subsidized?

New installations of solar panels (up to 5 kWp) and batteries (up to 30 kWh).



When should you order it?

From January 26th to April 30, 2026. Assignments are made on a strictly first-come, first-served basis; speed is key!

Key Figures and Requirements

Concept	Amount	Maximums
 Photovoltaic (Individual)	€600 / kWp	5 kWp = €3,000
 Photovoltaics (Collective)	€710 / kWp	5 kWp = €3,550
 Batteries	€420 / kWh	30 kWh = €12,600



Practical example of individual PV with battery

New 6 kWp solar installation + 10 kWh battery:

$$5 \text{ kWp} \times €600 = €3,000 \text{ for the panels} \quad + \quad 10 \text{ kWh} \times €420 = €4,200 \text{ for the battery}^*$$

Total subsidized: €7,200 of the installation cost.

*Batteries are eligible for subsidies when they are part of a new panel installation or an expansion of at least 1 kWp.
